# How will our proposals improve the situation?

- Helping the local economy by improving access to retailers and businesses.
- Improved quality, with upgraded bus infrastructure around the ringway.
- Improved passenger experience, by stopping on Abbey Street, and thus, avoiding delays on the ringway.
- Enhanced safety and security, with buses providing passive surveillance along Abbey Street and Harefield Road. This creates a sense of safety at quieter times.
- More convenient access
  to Grayson Place and the
  town's central shopping area
  for bus passengers.

Our proposals complement the Transforming Nuneaton ambition to redevelop Nuneaton bus station.

### Cars, Taxis & Delivery Vehicles



Newdegate Street: bring taxis closer to the centre by providing formal parking (evening only). Taxis to enter via new access controls.

**Dugdale Street:** prevent private cars parking on-street to enable lorries to manoeuvre.

Blue Badge Holder parking: to provide

Delivery driver parking: to provide designated spaces convenient access on the edge of the to the town centre pedestrian zone. (locations to be confirmed).

Ringway: variable Message Signs (VMS) to display available parking spaces in town centre car parks (locations to be confirmed).

### How will our proposals improve the situation?

- More convenient access to taxis in the town centre through the formalisation of parking around Newdegate Street.
- Better access for lorry drivers, with no stopping restrictions for cars.
- Improved roadside information, with Variable Message Signs (VMS) showing available car parking spaces and traffic information.

- Improved access for people with mobility and access needs, with designated Blue Badge holder parking on the edge of the pedestrian zone.
- Better delivery driver parking, with delivery drivers and riders benefiting from designated space to wait in.

# Pedestrian & Cyclist Proposals

Pedestrian zone:

upgrade paving and street-furniture and provide new planting.

Ringway: provide new signalised crossings and assess existing ones.

Traffic control
measures: review
pedestrian zone
access points.

Cycle routes and cycle stands: create cycle routes as per WCC Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP).

## How will our proposals improve the situation?

- Improved traffic control at pedestrian zone access points with new measures to restrict traffic.
- Designated cycle infrastructure to encourage people to travel to the town centre in a sustainable way providing health and environmental benefits.






