



Who Can Use Warwickshire County Council Transport?


The new plan for transport says that only some people will be able to have transport from Warwickshire County Council. It might be important for some people to have help with transport. This could be because they cannot get to their services without some help. It could also be because they do not have transport of their own and cannot travel by themselves.






Please tell us why you think this?

The new plan for transport says that sometimes transport might not be offered. This might happen if someone can travel by themselves or with a family or friend; this could mean using a public bus, a car or walking. If a person chooses to go to a service such as a day centre, a group or college which is not their nearest they might have to make their own plan to get there.



The new transport plan might mean that people cannot have support on their journey. This will be looked at during as part of their initial social work assessment.



When the changes will happen

The plan says that some people might not be able to have support with transport from WCC anymore. We would like to offer these people 1 month to make a new plan for travelling. This could include learning how to travel independently or to ask for a lift from a family or friend.
