

Northlands Primary School Change of Age Range Consultation FAQs

Q. Why is this consultation taking place?

A. Warwickshire County Council (WCC) is working with the school governors to review how nursery education places are provided at Northlands Primary School. This consultation is part of a statutory process for making prescribed alterations to schools, including changing the age range of a community school by 1 year or more.

Q. Who decides whether the change goes ahead?

A. Following the period of consultation, the County Council's Cabinet will review the feedback and make a decision on whether or not to go ahead with the changes.

Q. Where does the funding for the change come from?

A. There are no financial implications associated with these changes.

Q. What will be the effect on other educational establishments in the area?

A. Other local educational establishments in the area will be able to cater for additional demand and meet the requirements of working parents. Further information about other local educational establishments in the area can be found using the following [link](#)

Q. What happens if the County Council's Cabinet does not approve the proposed changes?

A. If the decision is not approved the school will remain with a maintained nursery class and continue to operate as they are currently.

Q. When will the changes be carried out?

A. A decision will be made so that any changes can be completed ready for the September 2019 term.

Q. Will there be any changes to the school's admission arrangements as a result of the change in age range?

A. The school's existing admission arrangements will remain the same.
