PROPOSED ROAD HUMPS (PRIORITY CROSSING FOR PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS) ON ACCESS ROAD TO GREENS HOME AND GARDEN CENTRE, OFF A428 RUGBY ROAD, BINLEY WOODS

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1 Warwickshire County Council is proposing, pursuant to Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to construct a road hump on the access road to Greens Home and Garden Centre off the A428 Rugby Road in Binley Woods (as described with approximate measurements in the Schedule below).
- 1.2 The road hump is being introduced to support a new cycle route along the A428 Rugby Road, between the existing cycle route and crossing facilities on the A46 to the west and junction of Rugby Road and Oakdale Road to the east. The Binley Woods cycle route will help to provide a safer connection between new cycle routes within Coventry and the Warwickshire settlement of Binley Woods. There will be benefits to pedestrians, cyclists and disabled users through widening and resurfacing the footway and improved signing.
- 1.3 The provision of a priority crossing supports the core design principles and other guidance for crossing low-trafficked side roads as set out in Local Transport Note 1/20 Cycle Infrastructure Design.
- 1.4 The design has been subject to Road Safety Audit review. High friction surfacing is proposed in a contrasting colour on the top of the ramp to highlight the crossing point. Tactile surfaces are proposed to indicate the transition between footway and carriageway for blind and visually impaired pedestrians.
- 1.5 The road hump is detailed on drawing number 66202784-SWE-XX-XX-D-C-1121 Rev P01.

SCHEDULE

Located on access road to Greens Home and Garden Centre at its junction with the A428 Rugby Road, Binley Woods.

Road hump dimensions: 7.4 metres (variable width) x 2.6 metres (length) x 0.075 metres (height)
